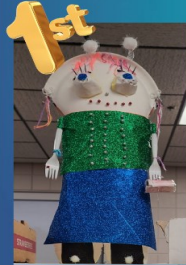
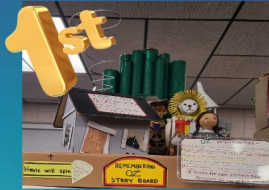

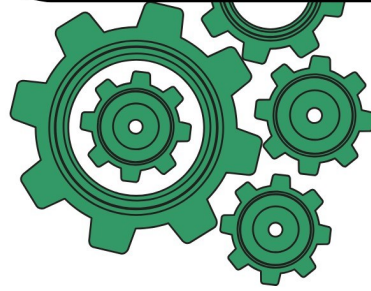

How do I Sign Up for Clubs and Upcoming Projects?
